Status: Permanent, Full Time.

Salary: Level 9.1 (\$81,435.53 per annum) dependent on experience.

Ordinary Hours: 152 hours per 4 weekly cycle, to be worked Monday to Friday between the hours of 6.00am and 6.00pm

RDO: 9 day per 2-week period.

Note: Ordinary hours will generally be worked as 8.5 hours for 8 days, 8 hours for one day and 1 Rostered Day Off in any 2-week period.
